

AV Instructions – Lobby

1. Turn on monitor

- Remote controls are located on the back side of the monitors. Using the remote control press the red power button - wait several seconds for the monitor to power on.

2. Select the appropriate input

- Input 1 – Digital Signage.
- Input 2 – Wireless Casting (Crestron AirMedia)

3. Using the Wireless Casting feature

- Once input 2 is selected you will see the Crestron AirMedia splash screen displayed
- To display your laptop, simply open an internet browser (Chrome/Firefox/Safari) and enter the following into the address bar <http://172.26.34.132> or <http://172.26.34.133> – depending on display. Once you press enter you will be taken to a Crestron landing page. From here select 'Start Presenting'. If you do not already have the Crestron AirMedia application, you will be prompted to download it. If this is the first time opening the application, you may need to accept a few terms and conditions before using it
- When you are prompted for a numeric password, use the four-digit number that appears on-screen
- If you are using a Mac you may need to select the AirPlay icon, then select the Crestron receiver which may be represented by the IP address above
- You can also connect a mobile device by downloading the corresponding app from the Play store (Android) or App store (iOS)

4. Connecting to the display once the Crestron application has been installed

- If you already have the Crestron application installed, then you do not need to go through the steps listed above. Simply locate the application – most likely in your downloads folder, open it, and enter the passcode on the screen.
